Minutes of the May 9, 2006 Meeting

Chairman Gregor called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Supervisors present were: George Weikert, David Waybright and Barbara Underwood. Others present were: Carol Merryman, Sgt. Molloy, Mike Galassi, Scot Pitzer from the Gettysburg Times and Meg Bernhardt from the Evening Sun. Supervisor Shealer and Ms. McLeish were absent. The meeting was tape-recorded.

Mr. Weikert made a motion to approve the Minutes of the April 25, 2006 meeting as presented, seconded by Mrs. Underwood and carried.

Mr. Waybright made a motion, seconded by Mr. Weikert and carried to approve the bills list in the amount of \$60,447.50 from the General Fund. Mr. Weikert stated, for the record, that he had a problem with the bill from Barco Products Company, in the amount of \$93.95, for the smoker's outpost that was placed at the entrance to the Police Department. He stated that, although this is probably better than a five- gallon bucket filled with sand, he does not think that the township should promote smoking in an area or pay for smoking accessories.

Sergeant Molloy presented a written and oral report of police activities for the month of April including: 208 complaints, 105 combined arrests and 18 incidents. He also reported that the department patrolled 6,695 miles of township roads in the month.

No visitors addressed the Board and there was no Old Business.

Mrs. Underwood made a motion to table the authorization to advertise a Burning Ordinance until more research can be done, seconded by Mr. Weikert and carried.

The Zoning Officer and Assistant Secretary's reports were reviewed.

Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:41 p.m. by motion of Mrs. Underwood, seconded by Mr. Weikert and carried.
