Both burial and composting are permitted disposal methods in PA, along with a couple other methods. I have attached a mortality disposal brochure that might answer a few of your questions. Unless there is an ongoing need for animal disposal, it wouldn't be required to be addressed in a manure management plan, but if they have animals, they need a manure management plan.
